RE: REPORT OF THE 60TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FORMATION OF THE E.A.B.I.C CHURCH OF SALVATION CONFERENCE SEMINAR REASONING.

Blessed love Royal house of the Ethiopia Africa Black International Congress Church of divine Salvation. Give thanks for life and the Mighty life Giver in flesh!

We the Royal Cabinet and Royal Parliament Members of the EABIC which was selected by our President, Most Rt. Hon. King Emmanuel Charles Edwards The Lords Servant, the Black Christ in Flesh. We bring to the attention of all Royal Congress members National and International, the long-awaited report of the EABIC 60th Anniversary (March 1st. 1958-2018) Conference Celebration Seminar Reasoning

As early as 2017, the original parliament and cabinet members, have been working with HQ assiduously every Sunday in preparation for the 60th Anniversary Conference Reasoning. The Members of the parliament abroad was asked by representatives at HQ to set the agenda. The members abroad did set the agenda which was fully endorsed by HQ. It was later sent out to be distributed to Congress members near and far.

It was agreed by members of the Parliament abroad and HQ that celebration service would commence on March 1, 2018 and follow through with Sabbath service, and on Sunday the 4th of March would be the opening of the Conference Seminar Reasoning. The agreement was not honored and a new agenda was set up at HQ, which led to the following.

On March 1, 2018 the Conference Reasoning started with the reading of The Constitution and declaring how it works. Amendment to The Constitution was mention. Congress members present were concerned about reformation, and suggested that the Panel should put in writing specific observations that the parliament would consider or deemed effective, such as; articles, subsections, and especially when it was mention that members abroad should not be on the parliament. Hon. Priest Bailey as the Leading Priest for the Conference and other Priests of the Panel did not recognize what was suggested by members in the congregation

It was also express by the Hon Priest Bailey in his deliberation that our intention was to keep conference reasoning outside HQ. We would like to make it known that it was our idea in the first place to have a reasoning of this magnitude to take place at our Congress HQ in Jamaica. We were also instrumental in sending barrels containing needed everyday supplies for members of the Congress, we contribute an enormous monetary strength that went towards material for putting a roof on the Tabernacle, and still suppling the Congress with food provision in a timely manner coming through Hon. Empress Esther, and Hon. Priest Bobo Dave who are and still remain an active part of the original Royal Cabinet and Parliament members that was established by King Emmanuel Charles Edwards. After all what we have done in the past and still, and never will stop doing, we are being accuse of such folly. Also despite the fact that there was a legitimate concern for security which stemmed from the situation that took place on the 6th of October 2017, it still did not keep us from attending the reasoning because at no time was it our intention to keep reasoning outside the Congress HQ.

Conference reasoning minutes 3/4/18

On Sunday March 4th the reasoning continued with the Constitution of the Congress as the 1st topic for discussion. It started with the Introduction, Membership, and the Sabbath sections of the Constitution by the Panel consisting of Hon Priest Bailey, Hon. Priest Headley, Hon. Priest Chris Morant, Hon. Priest Flego, and Hon. Priest Forrester. The keeping of the Sabbath principles were discussed and fully agreed upon by the Priests on the panel, and the congregation in attendance of Black Gods and Goddesses. The reasoning continued with the reading and discussion of the Sabbath section and the Membership sections specifying subsection points a, b, c, to letter k of the Constitution. Point (A) address the recognition of The Most Rt. Hon. King Emmanuel Charles Edward, Melchizedec the High Priest of Salem as defined in Hebrew Chapter 7, as The President and Head of the Association (EABIC Church of Salvation.) All who were present from the Panel to the congregation was in full agreement without confusion, contradiction, or reason to recognize anyone other than King Emmanuel Charles Edward as our worthy Founder, Leader, President God and King.

Some members wanted clarity on which individual would preside or oversee the 33 Man and Woman Parliament, or act in the capacity of the President, and would they be called chairman, or chairperson instead of President. Hon Priest Stewart contributed that Dada speaks as one voice through the 33 members of the parliament.

Point (j) of the membership section stressed by the Panel that no disrespect to our Royal Banners should take place anywhere it is being displayed, and also in our internal and external affairs, we must secure and fully represent the dignity, integrity, and reverence of our Creational Royal Banners. In no way should the Royal Banners be desecrated, sold, or loaned to a person, place or events contrary to our Foundational Principles that has been established by our Worthy Founder, Leader President, God, and King.

Letter (k) of the Membership section address working in unity, loyalty, and cooperation with each other. Hon Priest Bailey questioned the purpose and intention of the Agenda topics for the reasoning that was submitted by brethren in foreign to the HQ, and further stated that when they were received at HQ that he didn't know the name of the person who set the agenda. He next questioned whether the brethren in foreign were saying the same thing, working in unity, loyalty, and co-operation with each other as stated in point(k) of membership section. The declaration left the impression that the Brethrens in Foreign had some ulterior motive that was set forth and put in place contrary to the Constitution, purpose, and goals of the Congress. That accusation by Hon. Priest Bailey did not make any sense. the content of the agenda in question speak for itself, and proves that it is in no way contradictory to the Principles and objectives of the Congress. The agenda that was distributed is in circulation for all to see, that there is no evidence to support such folly stated by Hon. Priest Bailey. **Please note:** The Conference Agenda was set up in collaboration with Priests at the Congress HQ, that gave the go-ahead for Parliament members abroad to setup the Agenda as stated above in the earlier chapters. Also, are all the Congress members in United States working in full unity? Absolutely not. There is work to be done where that is concern. However, those that were personally groomed by king Emmanuel and others are working together in unity nationally and internationally.

The reasoning continued with the Panel addressing the Parliament section in regards to the difference of the Parliament and The Seven-Member Committee at the HQ being presented as the Parliament at the Sunday meetings. This was very confusing to some members of the Panel and the Congregation. The interchanging in the use of the words "Committee and Parliament" by the Hon. Priest Bailey were not being defined to recognize the difference in the operation of both offices. The seven-man committee is not the parliament, although members of the parliament are on the committee. The committee is for the daily operations and functioning of the Camp (HQ), while The Cabinet and The Parliament is the Governing authority of the EABIC Church of Salvation.

Hon Priest Flego member of the Parliament and the recently established Board of Directors at Congress HQ asked The Panel, where is Hon Priest Tall T? And further stated the Priest's lack of interest in being present was disrespectful. The Panel saw no reason for the Hon. Priest to be absent and could not speak of his whereabouts. Hon Priest Flego then inquired about Hon Priest Tall T's understanding of the NGO situation, no clearance was given.

Hon Priest Headley proceeded with the reasoning, that this conference has been planning for at least a year in anticipation for the necessary unification, upliftment and rectification of HQ and all congress locations 4 wings. He further stated that the March 1st 49th anniversary conference seminar did bring forth some structure and direction in the congress development, but certain mandates were not acted upon. Twenty-seven names were agreed upon for the parliament. Some reside in and some reside out of the camp, along with 14-member committee for the camp, was agreed upon at that time. The Hon. Priest continue to echo the need to show more loyalty to the Father and each other, one for all and all for one, consistency, and unity must prevail universally, and that sacrifice is part of our livity.

The next topic was; The Process of Anointing Priest. Concerns of newly selected Priests leaving HQ 2-3 weeks after being anointed. Hon Priest Stewart declared the duty and the office should be clearly understood ahead of the anointing process and perhaps taking back the office should be in place. It was also suggested that a seven-member Priest Committee should be in place at all times to select new acting Priest. Hon Priest Ogaro and Hon Priest Headley commented on the fact that a functioning Parliament would address and bring these concerns and other necessary matters to order.

Conference Reasoning Minutes 3/11/18

On March the 11th, the Conference Reasoning continued with the opening hymn by the leading Priest the Hon. Priest Bailey, along with the Hon Priest Headley, Hon. Priest Campbell, Hon. Priest Porter, Hon. Priest Chris Morant, Hon. Priest Forrester and Hon. Priest Archibald. These Priest would be further referred to as "The Panel." The congregation was informed by Hon. Priest Bailey that the matters regarding the parliament were discussed already, and this reasoning is about our domestic affairs. The Hon. Priest then proceeded with the Yard (domestic) reasoning. The Hon. Priest Morgan question the Priest regarding the International reasoning, and it was agreed that since Parliament members were present, further reasoning regarding the functioning, activation, and formation of the Parliament would continue so all voices could be heard. There was a domestic issue regarding a Hon. Priest that was not present in the reasoning. Hon. Empress Agilita stand and raised her hand to point out the fact that the Priest in question was not present. The Hon. Empress was told by Hon. Priest Bailey "sit down Empress because you don't live in the yard." **Note: Hon. Priest Bailey himself does not live in the Yard.**

This harsh comment was not well received by the panel or the congregation. It took several exchanges from the Priests on the panel and other members in the congregation to bring back the reasoning to calmness and to return to the topic of the conference international reasoning. Hon. Priest Bailey was asked to apologize to the Hon. Empress, which he refused to do. An apology went out to the Hon. Empress on behalf of the Panel. The International reasoning was

again put on hold upon the arrival of the Hon Priest that was accused in the domestic affair issue. After the issue was addressed the reasoning resumed and returned to Parliament discussion as the governing administrative body of the E.A.B.I.C. as stated in the Constitution.

Thirty-three man and woman members of the Parliament is to govern and ensure that the statutes, principles, and objectives of the E.A.B.I.C. Church of Salvation would remain upright, stable, practiced, and reinforced by following the correct interpretation of the Congress's Constitution, despite resistance within and without from unwanted opposition influences. The Rectification of HQ, and the Parliament would allow one voice to be established to fulfill the mandate established and set by our Divine Father, The Founder of our Congress.

It was also stated from the Panel by Hon. Priest Kevin that all could not be at the foundation at the same time, as this is a International Congress Government. Efforts were made before and must be repeated to replace Parliament members that have passed on or leave off the path. All should be on the same page as one solid family with one voice. King Emmanuel teaches us that a house divided cannot stand. Hon Priest Forrester added that we must function as one, to reach the better land. Hon Priest Bailey stated the parliament was active "in a sense" when Sunday meetings were being held at HQ to address duties, needs, concerns, and wants related to the Congress Government. He also stated parliament meeting could not be abroad, it must convene in HQ in Jamaica. He repeated, not having seen the Brethren in the yard for the past 10-15 years, conference calls were not effective, social media was not good for communication. Calls should come to HQ, not vice versa. **Note:** several phones and computers were sent to HQ yet there is no official Congress operating phone system available, only individuals.

Hon. Priest Bailey accused the members of the parliament that reside in United States of doing their own thing with no regards to the Headquarters in Jamaica, which is absolutely not true. Hon. Priest Bailey, Hon. Priest Shimron, Hon. Priest Flego and others on the Foundation was part of the Parliament reasoning that took place on Sundays until Hon. Priest Bailey decided for whatever reasons to no longer participate, while others were still participating. Hon Priest Flego emphasized that the EABIC is international, universal, worldwide because of the Fathers mighty works, it is still recognized as such 4-wings.

Hon Empress Esther followed with questions of why members outside Jamaica are not recognized as legitimate members, and representatives of the Congress? Also, she reminded Hon Priest Bailey of the past acceptance of his personal "coming and going" over the years. When making another effort to address or reason on other necessary points, Hon Priest Bailey abruptly disrespected Empress Esther by telling her that she was a "trouble maker". At this point it was necessary for The Panel along with members from the Congregation including the Emperesses to address the need to reaffirm the proper principles, integrity, and dignity, of the Congress. We must maintain and practice such principles, not just during reasoning, but at all times towards one another. Hon. Priest Bailey who is most outspoken in his opposition against the legitimate Congress members that reside abroad and does not reside on the Hill. Despite the fact that he lives in Jamaica, he himself does not live on the Hill. We also want to make it

clear and plain that the views of the Hon. Priest Bailey are not in its entirety the views of the Congress, and its members.

Questions next were introduced again in regards to Congress's NGO Status in the United Nations and UN interaction on related Parliament matters. Hon Priest Bailey explained that a 7-man committee, which was later increased to 14; apparently filled out a questionnaire that was submitted to the UN along with names to satisfy the UN requirements for NGO Status. His explanation was not fully detailed and therefore not satisfactory. During the reasoning, Hon. Priest Yacob declared that his recent search on the UN website regarding information on E.A.B.I.C. Church of Salvation NGO status, showed that such status has not been granted to the Congress. After the March 1st reasoning, Hon Priest Baily claimed that he received email from the UN, that apparently went to his personal email and not the Congress's email, stating that the Congress has been granted Observer Status. Parliament members ask to see such email and have not yet seen it to this present moment.

Hon Priest Ogaro in recognition of Parliament members abroad spoke to the fact that Parliament members been having phone conference reasoning for over a year trying to find positive ways and means to create upright actions to unify, benefit, and uplift the Congress internationally universally. He also informed the congregation that some Congress members at HQ were in support of the conference calls. Some participated and some did not recognize the brethren King Emmanuel selected that reside abroad. He further urged the need for greater unity, respect, and a paramount need for one voice.

Hon Priest Bailey accused the Hon. Priest Campbell and the Brethrens abroad of working a parliament outside of the Congress HQ. The Hon. Priest responded that there is only one Parliament, and that is the Parliament that was put together by our worthy Founder Leader President God and King at the Congress's HQ before his disembodiment. The Hon. Priest further stress that as Parliament members residing abroad, we refuse to not operate as members of Parliament, despite the fact that we are not living on the Foundation. Hon. Priest Bailey and the Congress HQ was and are fully aware of the fact that Parliament members that reside abroad were working with HQ as stated above. Hon Priest Campbell also suggested that Parliament meetings could take place every quarters in the year, which would be four times during a one-year period. That was a welcome thought by all present in the reasoning. The Hon. Priest further suggested that in the coming years Parliament meetings should be held in different geographical locations other than Jamaica such as; Africa, Bahamas, Trinidad, and other small Islands throughout the Caribbean, also South America and anywhere the Congress have a strong gathering, (if the environment is conducive of course). He also recognizes the fact that since we already have a foothold in Africa, we must move towards the rectification of the Africa missions in all African States where Congress members are situated, starting with Ghana, as the Congress's recognized gateway to Africa as soon as possible, not overlooking any important matters and must be thorough in doing so. The Priest also called for the youths within the Congress to be considered for a more active roll in the Congress moving forward with the guidance of the Elders that embraces the teachings of the Rt. Hon. King Emmanuel Charles Edwards.

The Panel also discuss the sharing of documents which will give more clarity and cohesiveness to the government and its various operations, and suggested the continuation of conference call meetings to maintain communication through devices such as phones, computers, and even regular mail. Hon. Priest Porter reinforced the need to cease counter productivity and return to one voice moving forward. Names of Parliament members approved at 49th anniversary conference reasoning that took place in Congress HQ Jamaica was also read by a member of the Panel.

Hon Priest Bailey and other Priests that actually reside on the Hill claim that Hon Priest Chris Morant was unfairly “attacked” by the brethren in foreign when he gave an interview to the Gleaner in regards to “deportation.” Hon. Priest Kevin responded by reminding the Brethrens on the Hill that there was more than one conference call reasoning that addressed the matter. It was agreed upon by all those on the conference line at the time, including those at the Congress HQ, for the Brethrens in foreign to contact the Gleaner and rectify the misunderstanding. The Parliament members that reside in Foreign did contact the Daily Gleaner and had the matter rectified. After reasoning on the issue both the Panel and the entire congregation agreed that the Congress is not agitating for Deportation, which is an entirely different approach from what the Congress’s aims and objectives are really about. The Congress is about Fundamental Freedom Redemption and International Repatriation.

This situation is another example of why the Parliament must be activated to protect the government with proper Public Relations Administration when it relates to media, to address local, national, and international issues and events pertaining to the interest of the Congress. Hon Empress Esther emphasized that those selected by the Father, in and out of the yard, have had prior valuable experience in dealing with these issues representing the Father, and are willing to pass it on to those who are willing to learn.

The Panel also made mention of Economic development which is being spearheaded by our State Department, wherein the Congress can benefit on a universal level, as long as we function within the parameters on the Congress’s Constitution. These developments are still being look into as we speak and will be further updated wherein all Congress members national and international will be aware of.

The reasoning ended and was set to continue on March 15, 2018.

Conference Meeting Minuets 03/15/2018

Hon Priest Headley resumed the reasoning on 3/15/2018 stating his real disappointment that all the Brethren from abroad could not or did not reach for the unity and activation of the parliament, which would have solved nuff problems for all Congress members four wings.

Hon Priest Bailey commented that after years of inactivity by parliament members, they at HQ went as far as to start parliament works with 7 persons; Hon Priest Sheppi, Hon Priest Morgan, Hon Priest Bailey, Hon Priest Morant, and others..., which went on till 7 more were added to comply with UN NGO project; Hon Priest Forrester, Hon Priest Neal, Hon Priest Archibald, Hon Priest Donovan, Hon Priest Par, Hon Priest Joseph. These Brethren made an effort from week to week. The original 7 started out to make it legal and functioning at HQ. Because some had inadequate ID, as regard to UN needs, the numbers were reduced to 7. **Again; The Hon. Priest is talking about Parliament works that was not made known to Parliament members residing outside of the Foundation, despite the fact that we abroad were in constant communication with HQ. Again, the seven-man were referred to as Board Members. Board members of what? This has not been made clear. Again, Parliament Members and Board Members are not the same. There are a lot of things being done at the Congress HQ, spearheaded by the Hon. Priest Bailey that demands clarity.**

Hon Priest Headley next moved the discussion towards the proper procedures in regards to Congress reasoning including the reading of the minutes. It was agreed upon by the Panel and members in the congregation that after the chairperson and the priest on the panel make their comments, then the reading of the minutes from the previous meeting would be read.

Hon Priest Rithmond next addressed the congregation regarding his experience as a member of the congress based upon the principles established by the Father's functioning standard, working together as one voice. The Priest further stressed that if we focus on what needed to be done we can do it, and that those who are selected to serve, and those who are not selected, should all still do their part to unite in one voice and uplift the government. Hon Priest Lamont spoke in support of those nominated to serve and suggested an immediate selection and replacement as relevant and necessary. Hon Empress Esther suggested a possible training session or workshop to help inform, prepare, assist, and guide aspiring parliament members to possibly help ensure proper guidance and good results.

Hon Empress Agileta added it was crucial for all parliament members to work together with or without portfolio. Hon. Priest Lamont added that an active Parliament with strong leadership functioning within the principles of the Black Christ Salvation, will bring other Bobo family members that reside outside forward to the Congress once again. The Hon. Priest also recalled assisting before in identifying various titles, offices and ministries in the government, and would be willing to assist again if needed. He urged all members to accept our glorious responsibility and don't take it simple or for granted.

Hon. Priest Ogaro and Hon. Priest Forrester added that some members were already experienced with and fully aware of the protocols of the government, and could help set it right for both younger and older members both near and far. On this 60th anniversary we should

strive to make the Parliament work as established by our Father and guided by the principles of the Constitution.

Hon Priest Headley next requested Hon Empress Esther, the leading Empress for the Congress and parliament member to give clarity on the woman 21-day purification principle, which she did. After that Hon. Empress Agileta asked for a clearance on Hon Priest Baileys earlier comment regarding NGO for UN accountability income relation. Hon Priest Bailey repeated that registration as NGO for UN require Congress to show accountability to the Jamaica government. Hon. Priest (Bobo) Dave then asked Hon Priest Bailey what he meant by accountability? Hon Priest Bailey said it is related to finances and income balance sheets. **Note; why should the Congress be accountable to the Jamaica Government? We are still not clear as to what is the relationship with the Congress's involvement with the Jamaica Government pertaining to the UN NGO status, and why is the Congress paying taxes as a church to the Government of Jamaica. It would appear that the Hon. Priest is being evasive in giving the congregation a clear definitive answer.**

Hon. Bobo Dave stated that according to the constitution the trustees of the Congress or those designated by the trustees of parliament should handle those affairs not the church. The church should have absolutely no relation with paying taxes. Hon. Priest (Bobo) Dave questioned Hon Priest Bailey if he knows what he is doing is not proper. What is being done is not being approached in the right manner.

After the reading of the March 14th minutes by Hon. Empress Esther. **Hon. Priest Rithmond and others raised concern about persons in N.Y., Africa, Bahamas and other congress locations supporting and advocating that Hon Priest Jesus to be President of the congress. It was strongly restated and emphasized by the Panel and the congregation that the Congress only recognize King Emmanuel Charles Edward as our one and only Worthy Founder, Leader, President, God and King.** The reasoning returned to the discussion concerning the selection of Parliament members, and identifying different ministries and titles within the Government. Names of various persons present at the reasoning were suggested. Hon Priest Morgan then addressed his personal working relation with the Congress; emphasizing the seriousness of the time, and representatives must recognize that this is a full time, lifelong commitment, "no play thing".

Further reasoning continued, relating to different offices and ministries within the Government and their functions. The manner of how the Government ministries and Parliament were being filled, Hon Empress Esther as an original Cabinet and Parliament member who have been working with the original Parliament members abroad and in Jamaica, rightfully requested her name to be removed off the new list being put together, because she refuses to work with any other Parliament other than the original. Having the knowledge and understanding of how the Parliament and various offices within the Congress/Government were established and functioning it was not being put together in that manner. However, if the Parliament is being establish right, dignified, respectable, and honorable, in the manner of how the original Parliament was set up, living up to the standard and working according to the

agenda establish by the Rt Hon. King Emmanuel Charles Edwards the Black Christ in Flesh, then we all know the Hon. Empress has no problem and will happily continue her work as a Royal Ambassador at large, Leading Empress, Cabinet and Parliament member as she has been doing before and after the Transition of King Emmanuel.

Hon Priest Porter stated that persons should only take the positions if they are serious about commitment, and must be action oriented, not just a title. Hon Priest Flego suggested that 2 or 3 parliamentarians should be able to work together on an ongoing basis. Cooperation within the parliament is most necessary and valuable. Hon Priest Ogaro, Hon Empress Agileta, and Hon Priest Rithmond all separately addressed the value of being able to work together and taking responsibility for all our individual actions. Hon Priest Ogaro also urged the committee and the parliament to combine their strength and work together according to the constitution set by the Father.

Hon Priest Lamont asked that the selection and action be decisive and agreed with Hon. Priest Rithmond that ones should not violate the constitution. Hon Priest Porter and Hon Priest Lamont spoke of rotating the chairperson of the parliament and taking full responsibility for maintaining all the principles, laws, commandments set by the Father 4 wings.

CONCLUSION

Going forward to the Foundation were full of uncertainties not knowing what to expect based on the unfortunate happenings that took place at the Congress's HQ, including but not limited to the burning of the Congress's Office building which housed letters, documents, etc... Yet, we were not deterred from attending the Conference Seminar Reasoning. Going up the Hill brought back a lot of great memories, it was a rough and rocky road, lots of changes due to rain over the years, it was not as steep as it once was in the 1980's and 90's.

Upon reaching the top of the hill it was a level drive entering through the two large gates of the Foundation. Within the Foundation, at the Old Camp Yard where we all once watch and prayed in the Royal Courts of King David. It was not looking so Royal as we once knew it with the Arches where no fire was allowed to pass through, and the strong fences painted with the bright Red Gold and Green and the Black Five Point Star.
